Work session discussion included mobile home of Jay Callan, sidewalks and the police contract with Johnson County.

Mayor Pro-Tem S. Brown opened the special meeting at 7:51 pm with roll call.

Lemley, K. Brown moved to draw up a contract for Jay Callan to sign on Thursday, that his mobile home will be removed by close of business on June 01, 2009, with a fine of \$10.00 per day to start accumulating Thursday, November 20, 2008, but if the mobile home is removed by June 1st, the fines will be forgiven. CARRIED with roll call vote of all Ayes. K. Brown, Larsen moved to check with Attorney Greenleaf about the possibility of posing a fine to the property owner on which the mobile home sits on and allows the violation to continue. CARRIED with all Ayes.

Lemley, Ogren moved to have City maintenance personnel check for lot pins and lot lines to see where sidewalks should be installed on Huskins Street and to give all property owners within the Ordinance regulations time frame notice that sidewalks are required to be installed by July 01, 2009 or the City will install them and assess the costs to the property. CARRIED with all Ayes.

Larsen, Lemley moved to adjourn the special meeting. CARRIED.

Mayor Pro-Tem S. Brown declared the meeting adjourned at 8:06 PM.
