## POLICY 2008 – 1 CITY OF LONE TREE YARD WASTE PICKUP RULES AND REGULATIONS

The purpose of the Yard Waste Pickup rules and regulations policy is to establish and maintain uniform procedures concerning yard waste pickup in a safe and cost-effective manner, taking into account, safety, budget, personnel, and environmental concerns.

This policy does not guarantee that yards will be free of yard waste after the execution of the yard waste pickup.

Operators must have a valid State of Iowa driver's license. An application with a copy of current driver's license shall be on file with the City Clerk before employment begins.

## Yardwaste (March – November):

Yard waste will be picked up every Monday of the month. Yard waste must be set at the roads edge (not in the street) by 7a.m. NO ALLEY PICKUP

- 1. Must be in a dumpable container that will drain water. Containers to be 40 gallon maximum capacity.
- 2. Cannot be more than 40 pounds per container
- 3. Do not place in garbage bags.
- 4. No wheel barrels to be used as containers.
- 5. Bundles 4' maximum length bundled with biodegradable materials.
